

Millsap High School Summer Reading 2010-2011

This year summer reading is only required for 9th and 10th grade students who are enrolled or planning to enroll in an Honors English class. The rationale behind summer reading programs is that students will stay engaged in learning during the summer months, increase their reading skills, and continue the commitment they have made to their education. These students must read the two books assigned for their specific class and pass the tests that will be given during the first week of school in order to remain enrolled in the Honors course. New students enrolling after August 23, 2010, the first day of school, will be given a two-week extension period to read the books, and then they will be required to take the tests.
