April 10, 2017

Ms. Elliot spoke about "Traps of a Trafficker". Mrs. Williams and Mrs. Farrar spoke very highly of the program and of Mary Elliot. Both ladies stated that Ms. Elliott was very professional and mindful of how this program would positively affect students. This program is for 7th - 12th grade students. SHAC members agreed to have the High School principal and Middle School principal meet with Ms. Elliot to see if they would accept this program for the 2017-2018 school year. Ms. Elliot has generously agreed to perform this program free of charge for MISD.

Recovery Resource Council: Mrs. Bradshaw spoke with Mrs. Martin concerning the LifeSkills Training Program given by Ms. Debra Gass for Elementary School students, and possibly 6th grade, for the 2017-2018 school year. This program is an eight week comprehensive, dynamic, and developmentally appropriate substance abuse prevention program. This program also builds upon itself so it can be taught again for students the next school year. This program is self-funded by a state grant.

There will be a special meeting scheduled to meet with Mrs. Bradshaw and SHAC members concerning this program. Also, a few SHAC members have volunteered to contact other school districts using this program to get their opinion about this program.
