## BYLAWS

- 1. Name and Purpose:
  - Millsap Independent School District School Health Advisory Council
  - To give advice and support to the district's comprehensive school health program which includes the following:
    - 1. Catch Health Program
    - 2. Misc. Exercise and Sports Programs
    - 3. Physical Education Curriculum
    - 4. Nutritional Services Program
    - 5. Counseling and Psychological Program
    - 6. Family and community Involvement Activities
    - 7. Staff Health Promotion Program
- 2. Membership:
  - Number of Members is 11 20
  - Members include parents, health care providers, business leaders, clergy, community members, government officials, school administrators, faculty, staff and students
  - Terms 1 year for community members / 2 years school personnel
  - Voting Rights all members present
  - Termination/Resignation requires a written request by member to be presented to the Chairperson
  - Selection Method volunteer/recruitment
- 3. Meetings:
  - Quarterly and As Needed
  - Location Millsap ISD
  - Agenda Request for agenda items to Chairperson 1 week prior to meeting
  - Notification of meetings letter with agenda or email
  - Conduction of Meetings informal, Roberts Rules of Order with formal recommendation
  - SHAC meetings are subject to "Open Meetings" laws

- 4. Officers:
  - Chairperson School Health Coordinator
  - Officers Co-Chair and Secretary
  - Terms 1 year
  - Voluntary
- 5. Voting Procedures:
  - Formal recommendations require a motion, second and vote
  - One- half of members must be present to vote (6min.)
- 6. Committees:
  - Addition sub committees to be formed as needed
  - Voluntary / Recruitment with representation from Council
- 7. Communications:
  - Communications regarding SHAC activities will be sent to council members and school administration.
  - Future agenda items will be discussed prior to adjourning
  - Items may be placed on agenda by submitting one week in advance to Chairperson.
  - SHAC activities will be reported in school newspaper
  - Records will be kept in the School Health Coordinator's office
- 8. Amendments to Bylaws:
  - Recommendations to amend bylaws should be placed on the agenda
  - Motion and second to amend bylaws with majority vote will result in a change in bylaws.
  - Amendments will be distributed to all SHAC members and school administration
