

7TH GRADE MATH

MATH HOMEWORK:

- Assignments are always started in class. Usually, students will be given the entire class period to work on the assignment. If the assignment is not completed in class, then the remainder of the assignment becomes homework.
- Some students will have homework; other students may never have homework. Assignments are completed at the individual pace of each student.
- Homework is due at the BEGINNING of the student's class period.
- INCOMPLETE homework will NOT be accepted.

HOMEWORK REMINDERS:

- When students have HW, I will send out a text/email reminder stating the name and due date of the assignment. This will go to both the students and parents.
- If a student does not turn in an assignment, both the parent & the student will receive a text/email stating the name of the assignment and the last late date.
- If a student does not turn in an assignment, an M (missing) will be entered into gradebook. The M calculates as a zero. If the student does not turn in the assignment within the allotted 3 late days, the M becomes a permanent zero.

SPIRALING REVIEWS:

- SR's are given every MONDAY and due the following FRIDAY.
- SR's should take approximately 30 minutes to fully complete.
- Some students may finish in 15 minutes, while other students may take 45 minutes.
- SR's can be done a little at a time...students have until Friday to get the SR fully completed.

MATH TESTS:

- Math tests are completed in class.
- We correct math tests in class (the day following the test) for half credit. Every student will correct their test regardless of the grade (unless a 100 is obtained).

MATH CHALLENGES:

- Math Challenges are extra points. These are the ONLY extra points that are given in math.
- Math Challenges are given the day after we take a test. They are usually worth 5 extra points per problem. Extra points for a math challenge can be anywhere from 20 to 30 points. These extra points are dispersed evenly throughout daily grades.
- Math Challenges are always due two days after the math challenge is received.
- Math Challenges may NOT be turned in LATE or INCOMPLETE.

FAILING AVERAGE:

- Parents will be contacted when a student has a failing average. Contact times are listed below:
 - At the end of the 2nd week of the six weeks via text/email
 - At the 3rd week of the six weeks via school-wide progress report
 - At the end of the 5th week of the six weeks via text/email

CANVAS:

- All lessons/assignments/SR's will be posted on Canvas.
- Students will be given a hard copy of all lessons/assignments/SR's.
 - Students will have access to print or view this on Canvas at any time. This is helpful when students lose or misplace assignments.
