

MHS Credit and Career Opportunities for Juniors/Seniors

[FIRE ACADEMY 12th W'ford College online at MHS and ESD #7 Fire Station](#)

WC TUITION COST: \$2352.

Fire Academy is a semester program for seniors in coordination with Weatherford College and Emergency Service District 7 (ESD 7). The online WC courses are taken on the MHS campus Monday - Thursday with Friday a fire hall hands-on day with ESD7. After the 14 weeks of online coursework there is a mandatory two week in-person boot camp at WC. ESD 7 provides bunker gear and job-embedded experience. Apply for DEG (Dual Enrollment Grant) through FAFSA completion. Scholarship money available with application through Workforce Solutions. MISD will pay for the textbooks, certification test and \$50 per semester toward tuition.

[CERTIFIED NURSE AIDE \(CNA\) 12th W'ford College {Evening classes available at this time}](#)

WC TUITION COST: \$750.

CNA is a spring semester program for seniors in coordination with Weatherford College. Seniors go to WC for instruction and complete clinical rotations at various health-care sites. CNA certification is a wonderful beginning place for students going into any health care field! The Bureau of Labor Statistics predicts a faster than average growth in this field. Full tuition scholarships (\$750) are available if you apply early. Scholarship money available with application through WC WEG funding and/or Workforce Solutions until funds are depleted. MISD will pay for the certification test and \$50 per semester toward tuition.

[CLINICAL MEDICAL ASSISTANT \(CMA\) 12th W'ford College {Evening classes available at this time} **NEW**](#)

WC TUITION COST: \$2700 (includes book and supplies)

CMA is a full year program for seniors in coordination with Weatherford College. Another great program in the healthcare field, training students to assist physicians in a medical office. The program consists of classroom instruction and off-site externship. The Bureau of Labor Statistics predicts a very high growth rate in this field. Scholarship money available with application through WC WEG funding and/or Workforce Solutions until funds are depleted. MISD will pay for the certification test and \$50 per semester toward tuition.

[DENTAL ASSISTANT 12th W'ford College {Evening classes available at this time} **NEW**](#)

WC TUITION COST: \$2300 (includes books and supplies)

Dental Assistant is a full year program for seniors in coordination with Weatherford College. This program prepares students for entry level positions in one of the fastest growing healthcare positions! The program consists of classroom instruction and off-site externship. The Bureau of Labor Statistics predicts a higher than average growth in this profession. Scholarship money available with application through WC WEG funding and/or Workforce Solutions until funds are depleted. MISD will pay for the certification test and \$50 per semester toward tuition.

[COMPUTER-AIDED DRAFTING \(CAD\) 11th-12th W'ford College {Evening classes available at this time} **NEW**](#)

WC TUITION COST: \$2380 (plus textbook)

CAD is a full year program for juniors and/or seniors in coordination with Weatherford College. Drafters use software to convert the designs of architects and engineers into technical drawings. Job growth is expected to continue rising. Scholarship money available with application through WC WEG funding and/or Workforce Solutions until funds are depleted. MISD will pay for the certification test and \$50 per semester toward tuition.

[CNC/MACHINING 12th W'ford College {Evening classes available at this time} **NEW**](#)

WC TUITION COST: \$1832

22CNC/Machining is a full year program for seniors in coordination with Weatherford College. Machinist and tool and die makers set up and operate machine tools to produce precision metal parts, instruments, and tools. This is a well paying occupation and many jobs are expected to arise from the need to replace workers who leave the occupation each year. Scholarship money available with application through WC WEG grants and Workforce Solutions. MISD will pay for the certification test and \$50 per semester toward tuition.

[INDUSTRIAL MAINTENANCE & AUTOMATION TECHNOLOGY \(IMAT\) 12th W'ford College {Evening classes} **NEW**](#)

WC TUITION COST: \$1896

IMAT is a full year program for seniors in coordination with Weatherford College. Industrial machinery mechanics install, maintain, and repair factory equipment and other industrial machinery. The Bureau of Labor Statistics predicts a much faster than average growth in this occupation. Scholarship money available with application through WC WEG grants and Workforce Solutions. MISD will pay for the certification test and \$50 per semester toward tuition.

[HEATING, VENTILATION & AIR CONDITIONING \(HVAC\) 12th W'ford College {Evening classes available at this time} **NEW**](#)

WC TUITION COST: \$3164 Level 1-\$500 (plus book and study guide), Level 2-\$1332, Level 3-\$1332

HVAC is a full year program for seniors in coordination with Weatherford College. HVAC technicians work on heating, ventilation, cooling, and refrigeration systems that control the temperature and air quality in buildings. The Bureau of Labor Statistics predicts a steady growth in this occupation. Scholarship money available with application through WC WEG funding and/or Workforce Solutions until funds are depleted. MISD will pay for the certification test and \$50 per semester toward tuition.

[ELECTRICAL APPRENTICE 12th MHS and job site](#)

TUITION COST: No cost. Electrical is an earn-as-you-learn job-embedded program.

Electrical Apprentice is a full year program for seniors in coordination with the Ft.Worth/Tarrant County chapter of the IEC (Independent Electrical Contractors) and a local electrical contractor. Seniors begin classroom instruction at Millsap High School with a certified electrical trainer and work 1-2 days a week for an electrical contractor the fall semester. The spring is complete job-embedded work earning intern house and a paycheck!! This apprenticeship continues after graduation to gain a Journeyman license, with students attending an evening class once a week, while continuing to be fully employed!! IEC covers tools and gear cost. MISD covers textbook costs and ESD #7 provides bunker gear.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN certification (EMT) 12th WHS (not being offered 2021/2022)

WHS TUITION COST: \$1000 to WHS and lab supplies approximately \$745.

EMT is a full year program for seniors in coordination with Weatherford High School. Seniors attend class on the WHS campus with clinical rotations in the spring. EMT certification can lead to a rewarding career in itself, or be a stepping stone to further training. All firefighters are required to have EMT certification. Scholarship money available with application through Workforce Solutions. MISD will pay for the certification test and \$50 per semester toward tuition.

CERTIFIED PHARMACY TECHNICIAN (CPT) 12th WHS and job site

WHS TUITION COST: \$1000 to WHS; urinalysis \$30, fingerprint and background check \$50

CPT is a full year program for seniors in coordination with Weatherford High School. Median pay for pharmacy techs usually starts at \$15.00 per hour, making it a great way to earn money while continuing your education? Scholarship money available with application through Workforce Solutions. MISD will pay for the certification test and \$50 per semester toward tuition.

COSMETOLOGY 11th and/or 12th W'ford Ninth Grade Center

WHS TUITION COST: \$1500 to WHS and lab supplies approximately \$500.

COSMETOLOGY is a full year program for juniors and/or seniors in coordination with Weatherford High School. The classroom work can begin in the junior year (500 hrs), and continue in the senior year (500 hrs), or seniors can begin their program and complete it at Weatherford College after graduation. Scholarship money available with application through WC WEG and Workforce Solutions. MISD will pay for the certification test and \$50 per semester toward tuition.

AUTO TECHNOLOGY 11th and/or 12th W'ford Ninth Grade Center

WHS TUITION COST: \$1500 to WHS

AUTO TECH is a full year program for juniors and/or seniors in coordination with Weatherford High School. Scholarship money available with application through Workforce Solutions. MISD will pay for the certification test and \$50 per semester toward tuition.

CULINARY ARTS PRACTICUM 11th and/or 12th at MHS and possible job site

TUITION COST: No cost. Can be an earn-as-you-learn job-embedded practicum.

The MHS Culinary Arts Practicum is a full year program for juniors and seniors as a paid job-embedded experience in the MISD food services. Jobs in the culinary industry are predicted to grow at a steady rate of 5 to 6%, making this an attractive career choice for those enjoying these skills. Prerequisite: Food Manager Certification.

DIGITAL COMMUNICATIONS PRACTICUM 11th and/or 12th at MHS and possible job site

TUITION COST: No cost. Can be an earn-as-you-learn job-embedded practicum.

The MHS Audio Video Production Practicum for juniors and seniors can be a paid job-embedded experience in MISD. (First three committed MHS practicums are paid.) Prerequisite: Adobe Certified Associate Premiere Pro.

DESIGN AND MULTIMEDIA ARTS PRACTICUM 11th and/or 12th at MHS and possible job site

TUITION COST: No cost. Can be an earn-as-you-learn job-embedded practicum.

The MHS Commercial Photography Practicum for a full year program for juniors and seniors and can be a paid job-embedded experience in MISD. The Bureau of Labor Statistics projects jobs in this industry to grow at a moderate rate. (First three committed MHS practicums are paid.) Prerequisite: Adobe Certified Associate Photoshop.

AGRICULTURE, FOOD, AND NATURAL RESOURCE (AFNR) PRACTICUM 11 and/or 12 at MHS and possible job site

TUITION COST: No cost. Can be an earn-as-you-learn job-embedded practicum.

The AFNR Practicum for a full year program for juniors and seniors and can be a paid job-embedded experience at a local shop. Prerequisite: OSHA and AWS Sense certifications for shop practicums.

Each of these programs offer students the opportunity to begin developing their career before high school graduation, as well as gain industry based certification, making them more attractive employees!
